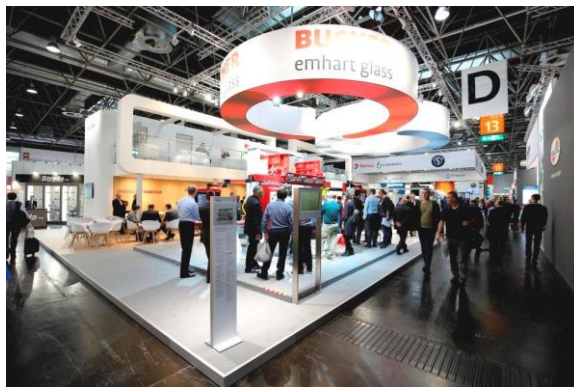
### **Bucher Emhart Glass informs about its glasstec participation and forward thinking measures and decisions**
